We are very pleased that we opened our doors once again on the 4th July 2020 and with all your support we have managed to survive so far without any critical incidents.

You now only need to book the tables in the restaurant, all other areas are on first come first served basis. We do have large grounds with covered areas available with outside service points.

Safety is our main priority and concern, and anyone who has been recently, will know that we are taking every precaution that we can to ensure customer and staff safety.

Anyone who has not been will not be aware that we have installed a Thermal Imaging Camera, safety PPE & glass screens.

As we move forward, we have now adjusted the furniture on the inside of the pub so that we can have several tables available to allow drinking indoors. Whilst this is a move forward and drinks can be ordered from the inside service point, it is still not possible to allow standing at the bar currently. However, we feel that this is at least a halfway house to being normal again, but we would ask all our customers to stick to the current govt. guidance as and when applicable.

As more brewers come back online, we will be endeavoring to increase the range of beers and ales available as soon as practically possible.

The good news is that we have registered for "EAT OUT TO HELP OUT" which offers 50% of your food bill up to £10 per person from 3rd August to 31st August every week on Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday only. We think that this is an excellent deal and hope that you will take full advantage of the govt. offering.

For example, this would equate to having our favorite Pork Dish with a dessert at a cost of £22. With the maximum discount of £10 off it means that you would only pay £12!!

Book early for the restaurant or join us outside to enjoy the menu

We are, on a weekly basis, continually adding dishes to our menu as and when finer ingredients are more readily available. We are always doing 2 Roasts on Sundays

Food service will run from Midday to 9pm every day in the garden. The restaurant will go dark Monday to Friday between 3pm - 6pm, but food service will be available from the outside service point from 12-9pm daily. If the weather becomes unpredictable, we will be reviewing the opening of the restaurant.

We welcome all, however, our younger members (under 14) will need to remain seated and will need adult supervision when using the toilets. The toilets will continue to be controlled, as will all the entrances and exits to the premises.

In summary we believe that we have embraced the changes, and yes on occasions we have not got things wrong, but we are continually adjusting and trying to cater for all needs whilst staying safe. With your continued support we can hopefully continue to trade successfully and keep the Village Pub trade alive and well!
